We delivered on all what we had promised for **term x**. Our Candidates have been exposed to a number of preparatory assessments, test and examination to which they fared so well. We have used the services of **Senior Colleagues** from other schools to beef up our staff efforts. This arrangement produced the desired goals.

The Board has mandated the **Finance Committee** and **management** to study and make consultations on the revised **school fees structures** forwarded by the Consultants, **Ernest and Young** in their **April report** that sparked off the re-organisation process. We shall inform you accordingly.

Instruction in the continuing classes SI, SIII and SV UNEB and Cambridge is well on course. Most of the new students that joined school are **disciplined** and **focused**. They are **well – motivated** and **Competitive**. They have added new aroma into our Class competitiveness. The school and student future is bright.
